Grade School Olympics is a fun, full day (9:30 - 3:00) Track and Field event at Fort Lewis, Washington for <u>1st through 8th grade</u> students from the Lutheran Schools in Oregon and Washington. Families are encouraged to transport their students and spend the day cheering them on in their running, jumping, and throwing events.

A parent letter / driver registration form is attached to this note for this year's Olympics that are being held on **Friday, May 6, 2022** at Joint Base Lewis McChord (Fort Lewis), Washington. In order to make use of the athletic fields at this military facility, **we need all drivers and passengers to pre-register**. This form requires registration of drivers/passengers who are 16 years and older - no vehicle registration is required on this form. Contact your child's teacher or the school office with questions.

Please read, complete and return the completed registration form by Thursday March 10th

Even if you're not sure whether you will be attending the Olympics, it is recommended that you *register just in*

case. You will not be able to attend if you do not fill out a form.

If you have an **Oregon** driver's license you will be required to present another form of accepted ID. Some examples are: Passport or Passport Card, or school ID card with picture for high school students. <u>Parents are</u> responsible for transporting and supervising their children at this activity OR making arrangements for someone else to transport and supervise them.
